7. <u>Weather Forecast for Next 24 Hours by PMD</u>. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore, DG Khan & Bahawalpur Divisions. Scattered thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity is expected over Sindh and East Balochistan.

## 9. Weather Advisory / Press Release

- a. In response to PMD weather alert NDMA has issued weather advisory to all concerned on 26<sup>th</sup> August 2021 that more monsoon currents are likely to penetrate in upper parts of the country from Friday (Evening/Night) and likely to continue till Wednesday (27<sup>th</sup> August 01<sup>st</sup> September 2021). Under the influence of this weather system, following is predicted: -
  - (1) Rain-wind-thundershower is expected in Kashmir, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Lahore, Okara, Faisalabad, Sargodha, Mianwali, Kohistan, Shangla, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Mardan, Charsadda, Nowshera, Dir, Chitral, Peshawar, Kohat, Waziristan, Gilgit-Baltistan (Ghizer, Astore, Diamir, Skardu, Gilgit, Hunza, Nagar, Ghanche and Kharmang) with occasional gaps from Friday (Evening/Night) to Wednesday (27th August 01st September 2021).
  - (2) Heavy falls are also expected in Dir, Kohistan, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Muzaffarabad, Rawalpindi/Islamabad, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Lahore and Kasur from Sunday night to Tuesday (29<sup>th</sup> 31<sup>st</sup> August 2021).
  - (3) Rain-wind-thunderstorm is also expected in Tank, Karak, Bannu, D.I. Khan, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Bhakkar, Layyah, Sahiwal, Bahawalnagar,

Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Khanpur, Khanewal, Multan, Kohlu, Loralai, Barkhan, Zhob, Musa khel, Quetta, Ziarat and Kalat on Monday (Evening/Night) and Wednesday (30<sup>th</sup> August - 01<sup>st</sup> September 2021).

- b. In response to PMD weather alert NDMA has issued weather advisory to all concerned on 31st August 2021 that monsoon currents presently giving rains in upper/central parts of the country are now likely to give more rain thunderstorm in southern parts of the country:
  - (1) Rain-wind-thundershower (with Isolated heavy falls) are expected in Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Shaheed Benazirabad, Hyderabad, Badin, Thatta, Karachi, Jamshoro, Dadu, Larkana, Sukkur, Jacobabad, Kohlu, Barkhan, Sibbi, Loralai, Musakhel, Zhob, Ziarat, Quetta, Pishin, Mastung, Naseerabad, Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbella and Awaran districts from Tuesday evening/night to Friday (31st August – 3rd September 2021).
  - (2) Rain-wind-thunderstorm is also expected in South Punjab (Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Multan, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur and Rahim Yar Khan on Tuesday and Wednesday (31st August 1st September 2021).

• 2 x Bridges i.e. Ayub bridge & Nowshera bridge were damaged in District Abbottabad on 11 July 2021.

## Balochistan.

1 x Bridge was damaged in District Sibbi on 20th July 2021.

## Gilgit Baltistan.

#### Foot/ Wooden Bridges:

- Chirah Wooden suspension Bridge (pedestrian bridge) got damaged in District Gilgit on 28th July 2021.
- 1 x Wooden Bridge at Yashkuk glacier got damaged in District Hunza on 30th July 2021.
- 1 x Wooden Bridge on Road Zoodkhun to Ziarat got damaged in District Hunza on 31 July 2021.

## Road Bridges:

- 1 x Truss Bridge about 40 ft span on Road Zoodkhun to Ziarat got damaged in District Hunza on 31 July 2021.
- Bailey Bridge on Thogmus nullah got damaged in District Ghanche on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
- Sholja Bridge got damaged in District Ghizer on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
- 1 x Bridge got damaged in Badswat, Ishkoman Valley on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
- Mirmalik Bridge got damaged in District Astore on 28<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
