SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Sutlej at Sulemanki is in High flood level. River Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala & Islam and River Indus at Tarbela & Guddu are in low flood level.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northeast Afghanistan and adjoining areas persists.
- b. Moderate to strong moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 4000 feet.
- c. Marked seasonal low lies over Northeast Balochistan and its trough is extending Northeastwards.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered to widespread wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers, Islamabad along with Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha & Lahore Divisions. Isolated wind thunderstorm/rain is also expected over DI Khan & DG Khan Divisions.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:

Wet spell is likely to continue.
