5. Weather Forecast for Next 24 Hours by PMD. Scattered thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Peshawar, Kohat, Banu, D.I.khan, Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Multan & D.G.Khan Divisions. Scattered to widespread thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy to very heavy falls is expected over Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sahiwal & Bahawalpur Divisions. Isolated

thunderstorm/rain is expected over Sindh and East Balochistan.

- 7. Weather Advisory / Press Release. In response to PMD Weather Forecast, NDMA has issued weather advisory to all concerned on 19th July 2022, that strong monsoon currents are likely to penetrate Upper & Central parts of the Country from 20 July (Wednesday) and likely to spread to other parts of the Country from 21 July (Thursday), under the influence of this system, following is expected: -
 - a. <u>Islamabad Capital Territory</u> More rain-wind / thundershowers with scattered heavy falls expected in Islamabad with occasional gaps from 20-26 July (Wednesday-Tuesday).
 - b. <u>Balochistan More rain-wind / thundershowers with few heavy falls expected in</u>
