**SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:****I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:**

River Indus at Chashma & Taunsa is in Medium flood level. River Indus at Tarbela & Guddu, River Kabul at Nowshera, River Ravi at Balloki and River Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala & Sulemanki are in Low flood level.

**ALERT:** Flash flooding of Moderate to heavy intensity is expected in the Nullahs of Balochistan (Loralai, Kalat, Sibbi, Makran, Nasirabad Divisions) and Hill Torrents of D.G Khan Division during next 24-hours. **Flash flooding is also expected in the Tributaries of River Kabul after 48-hours.**

**II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a. A fresh trough of westerly wave lies over Northern parts of Afghanistan.
- b. A trough (remanent of monsoon low) lies over Sindh.
- c. Moderate to Strong moist currents from Bay of Bengal and Arabian Sea are penetrating to lower half of the country up to 5000 feet, while light to moderate currents are penetrating to upper half of the country up to 5000 feet.
- d. Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan.

**III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:**

Scattered to widespread wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with heavy falls at isolated places is expected over South & Southeast Sindh along with Zhob, Loralai, Kalat, Sibbi, Makran, Nasirabad, D.G. Khan, D.I. Khan, Bannu & Kohat Divisions. Scattered wind thunderstorm rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Peshawar Division & rest of Punjab and Sindh .

**IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:**

Current wet spell is likely to continue over most parts of country and subside over Sindh.



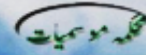
