- JS/DA Started in 31 x Districts; likely completion by 30<sup>th</sup> Sep 2022

#### b) Gilgit Baltistan (6 x Dist)

- 4 x Teams (1x PCT & 3 x FSTs) are in GB. Movement of teams started 6<sup>th</sup> Sep 22
- JS/DA started from 12<sup>th</sup> Sep 22; likely completion by 30<sup>th</sup> Sep 22

## c) Punjab (3 x Dist)

- 3 x Teams (1 x PCT & 2 x FSTs) are in Punjab. Movement of teams started 8th Sep 22
- JS/DA started form 15<sup>th</sup> Sep 22; likely completion by 30<sup>th</sup> Sep 22
