**SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:****I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:**

All the Major Rivers are flowing Below Low Flood level.

**II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a. Yesterday's Low-pressure area over North Bay of Bengal today lies over South Odisha coast.
- b. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northeast Afghanistan today lies over Northern parts of the country.
- c. Mild moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- d. Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan.

**III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:**

Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain of light to moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers, Islamabad along with Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Sargodha & Gujranwala Divisions. Isolated wind thunderstorm/rain is also expected over Lahore & DG Khan Divisions.

**IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:**
